



Forest Nursery Association of BC Educational Award

Rules and Regulations

The purpose of this award is to assist worthy students who are FNABC members or sons/daughters/grandsons/granddaughters/employees of an FNABC member to further their post-secondary education.

1. Two annual awards for \$1000 each will be determined by the FNABC award committee by November 15 of each calendar year.
2. Application for this award will be accepted any time prior to Noon, September 16, 2019.
3. Applicants must be sponsored by a member of the Forest Nursery Association of BC, and applications signed by the member sponsor.
4. Applicants must be planning to enter or returning to post-secondary education within the 12 month period following the application deadline.
5. Financial need may be a qualifying criterion, depending on applicants. Please outline your budget for the next year (include income and expenses). The following is a sample format:

6. Preference for this award will be given to a student that is entering into field horticulture, agriculture or a forestry-related field of study.
7. The Forest Nursery Association of BC (Scholarship Award Committee) is empowered to: -grant this educational award at its discretion; withhold this educational award in any year if there are no eligible applicants or for any reason deemed advisable.
8. The award will be payable on receipt by the FNABC of documentation (e.g. unofficial transcripts) confirming acceptance or continuation into a post-secondary institution.
9. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

1. A brief letter describing your various interests, experience and reasons you feel qualified for this award.
2. A document from your high school or attending educational institution summarizing your academic standing and record.
3. A copy of your most recent transcripts of previous year's marks. (Official transcript not necessary)
4. Your budget for the year, including anticipated sources of income and expenses (see above template).
